### **Assembly And Installation**

**IMPORTANT!**: The FCAC Series frames can be assembled at a variety of widths in 2" increments using any of the holes available in the center joiner tubes (F) depending on display size and user preference. Holes shown being used in the graphics throughout these instructions are just as examples.

#### Frame Assembly

#### FCAC1L

 Slide together two outside frames (C) and two center joiner tubes (F). (See Figure 1)



2. Use four #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure outside frames (C) to center joiner tubes (F). (See Figure 2)



 Use four #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure LCM upright (H) to two center joiner tubes (F). (See Figure 3)



4. Proceed to "Fabric Cover Installation" Section.

#### FCAC1X

- Slide together two outside frames (C) and two center joiner tubes (F). (See Figure 1)
- Use four #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure two uprights (D and E) to two outside frames (C). (See Figure 4) If installing to cart or stand, use #12-11 x 1 1/4" Phillips tapping screws (P) instead and four 3/4" spacers (N) to create more space for back of cart/stand. (See Figure 5)





3. Proceed to "Fabric Cover Installation" Section.

#### FCAC2X1M/FCAC2X1L

1. Slide together two outside frames (C), four center joiner tubes (F) and one center frame (B). (See Figure 6)



NOTE: If there are any possible obstructions on back of display that could interfere with uprights (D and E) installation, measure where they will occur so uprights can be attached accordingly. Uprights (without flags) (D) may be installed in either Step 2, Step 4 or into any available holes on center joiner tubes (F) depending on obstructions or user preference.

 Use four #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure two uprights (without flags) (D) to outside frames (C). (See Figure 7) **NOTE:** Example shown (See Figure 7) is to assemble a maximum length frame. Frame can be made shorter and must be shorter for FCAC2X1M.

3. Use two #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure upright (with flag) (E) to center frame (B). (See Figure 7)



 Use four #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure four center joiner tubes (F) to center frame (B). (See Figure 8)



5. Proceed to "Cover Installation" Section.

#### FCAC3X1M/FCAC3X1L

 Slide together two outside frames (C), two extension frames (M) and center frame (B). (See Figure 9)



NOTE: If there are any possible obstructions on back of display that could interfere with uprights (D and E) installation, measure where they will occur so uprights can be attached accordingly. Uprights without flags (D) can be installed in Step 2 as shown or separately in any available holes in extension frames (M).

 Use six #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure three uprights (without flags) (D) to outside frames (C), extension frames (M) and center frame (B). (See Figure 10)

**NOTE:** Example shown (See Figure 10) is to assemble a maximum length frame. Frame can be made shorter and must be shorter for FCAC3X1M.

 Use two #12-24 x 3/8" Phillips tapping screws (G) to secure upright (with flag) (E) to center frame (B). (See Figure 10)



#### **Fabric Cover Installation**

Wrap fabric cover (A) over assembled frame. (See Figure 11)



- Wrap outside straps around outside vertical rails on frame. (See Figure 12)
- 3. Fasten vertical straps within cover to ensure a snug fit over frame. (See Figure 12)



# Installation to Display Mount FCAC1L

 Use four 5/16-18 x 3/4" button head cap screws (K) to secure LCM upright adapter (J) to back of LCM mount. (See Figure 13)



- Make sure mounting flag on LCM upright (H) is in the "open" position. (See Figure 14)
- 3. Hang LCM upright (H) onto mounting buttons on back of LCM upright adapter (J). (See Figure 14)
- Move mounting flag on LCM upright to the "closed" position. (See Figure 14)



## FCAC1X/FCAC2X1M/FCAC2X1L/ FCAC3X1M/FCAC3X1L

 Lift assembled cover onto top edge of mounting rail. (See Figure 15)






Figure 16



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

- Pull down mounting flag and pull under lower edge of mounting rail. (See Figure 16)
- Release mounting flag to secure cover to rail. (See Figure 16)
